SUPPORT FOR "OTSEGO COUNTY: ONE COUNTY, ONE VISION"
LAND USE REPORT

At a regular meeting of the _____ township _____, held on the 11 day of October, 2004, _____ Milbocker made a motion to adopt the following Resolution in support of the 'One Vision Land Use Report', the motion was supported by _____ Huff

WHEREAS the Township Officials along with the Otsego County Planning Commission members, City of Gaylord Officials, Village of Vanderbilt Officials, Otsego County Economic Alliance, and members of the community recognized the size and scope of land use issues confronting Otsego County; and

WHEREAS the Officials from all of the Municipalities along with members of the community organized a "Growth Management Roundtable"; and

WHEREAS the 'Growth Management Roundtable' participants engaged the services of a professional Land Use Planning consultant to assist in obtaining Countywide comments regarding the creation and implementation of a community vision for Otsego County; and

WHEREAS over a period of several months Otsego County residents participated in public meetings, completed surveys, provided personal stories and critiqued reports that resulted in the creation of "Otsego County: One County, One Vision", and

WHEREAS _____ Charlton _____ Township realizes that critical to good decision making is realizing present conditions, and determining what citizens desire for the future of the County, and

WHEREAS the "Otsego County: One County, One Vision" report identifies specific areas that should be preserved and it outlines the direction residents wish their county to pursue.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that _____ Charlton _____ Township fully supports the "Otsego County: One County, One Vision" report and accepts the report as a tool to be used by the Otsego County Planning Commission in updating the current Otsego County Master Plan, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that _____ Charlton _____ Township fully supports the "Otsego County: One County, One Vision" report and accepts the report as a tool to be used by Otsego County to initiate discussions with the City of Gaylord and The Village of Vanderbilt for the establishment of Joint Planning Commissions for the review of certain specific projects that may be proposed for locations that are determined to be sensitive or critical areas requiring review by multiple municipalities.
