## Dayton Trip Update

Rental here in Gaylord has a 1 passenger van available for \$90 a day. From Gaylord to Dayton is about 40 statute miles. Driving costs would vary depending on how many went. If eight of us go and stay two to a room the estimate of costs might be:

1/8 <sup>th</sup> Fuel	\$ 5
1/2 Motel	150
1/8 <sup>th</sup> Car	<u>50</u>
	\$ 5

Please understand that the above costs are just guesses. I don't guarantee them and meal costs and admissions would be extra.

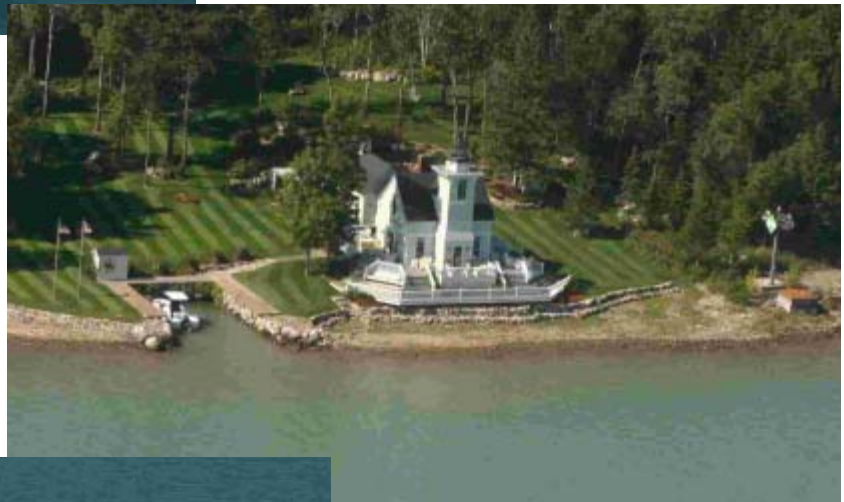

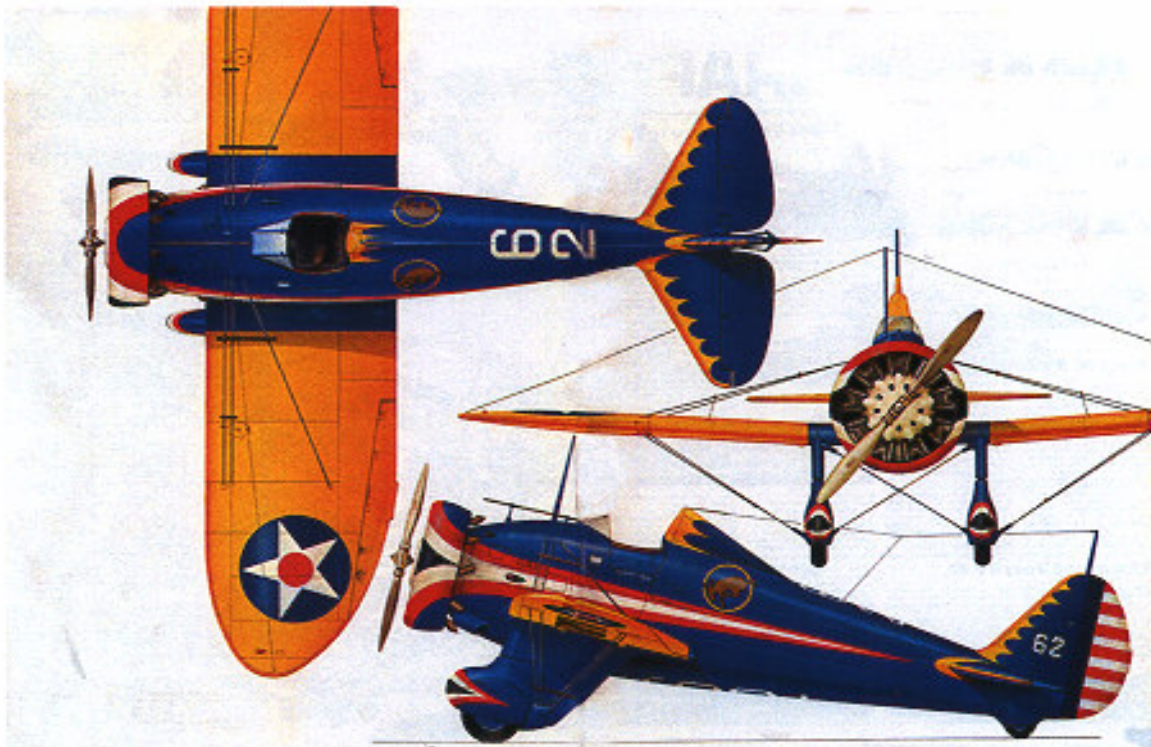
