Identify a Microclimate! Getting an Early Start!

James Fizzell, in his book" Gardening in Michigan, Month by Month", while discussing annuals, calls us to notice how some plants survive the frost at the end of the season. He would like us to remember the plants with frost tolerance because this will help us to decide what plants to set out in early spring. Petunias, snapdragons, moss roses, and verbenas, can withstand a little cold and can be set out earlier. Other plants survive because they are protected. Overhanging trees, the warmth, south side of the house, taller garden plants—all create microclimates that ward off the cold. I learned that a microclimate is a small but distinct climate within a larger one. A sunny spot protected from the wind, for example is a microclimate. In that spot, you might be able to grow plants that would not be able to handle the cooler areas of your property. And you can plant these areas earlier in the spring.
