George asked for volunteers to go on an inter club this month. It was decided to go to Saint Ignace on March 23rd. This was canceled because of the storm. George will reschedule.

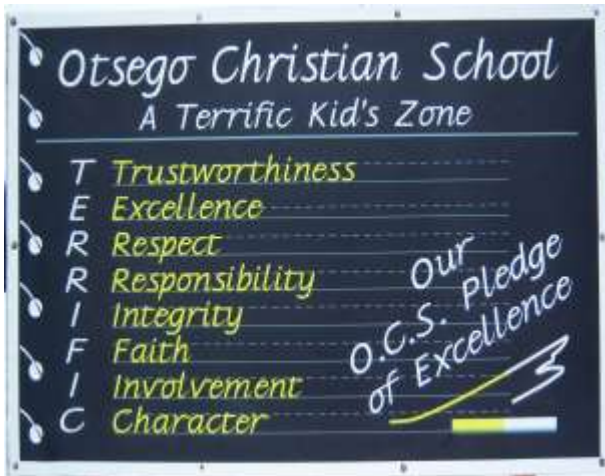
