

Quality of Life

Quality of life is different for each of us but, in general, it is an expression that summarizes opinions about our community. It includes attributes like friendliness, health care, safety, recreation, natural resources, educational and employment opportunities which together determine whether our county is a desirable place to live and work.

The aim of this community assessment was to gain a better understanding of the quality of life in Otsego County. What makes our county a desirable place to pursue a career, raise a family, and retire in comfort? To find the answers to these and other concerns we embarked on a comprehensive approach that included the following activities:

- Collected and posted to our web site existing reports, statistics, and other data related to the quality of life in Otsego County.
- Conducted a public opinion survey in November 2011and received a return rate of nearly 50% from the random sample of 1167 registered voters. See Appendix A for survey results.
- Conducted an on-line survey in early 2012 as a follow up to gain additional input related to the original public opinion survey. Survey questions with responses are included in Appendix B.
- Convened a youth input session during Spring Break 2012 to provide area high school students an opportunity to express their ideas and opinions. See Appendix C for details.
- Held Community Conversations in Elmira, Waters, Vanderbilt, Johannesburg, and Gaylord in May 2012. See Appendix D for the summary of the input from the nearly 50 participants.
- Hosted a Community Assessment Team (CAT) in September 2012 to gain the perspective of outside experts. The Team's report is available in Appendix E.


Quality of Life Indicators - 2012 Report Card



Intended Outcomes:

- Identify community assets and needs
- Discover the perceptions that residents have about their quality of life
- Create a baseline for future comparisons and measure change over time
- Identify gaps and reduce overlap in services and program delivery
- Provide information and justification for grant applications
- Help local units of government, businesses, and nonprofit organizations make informed decisions based on public opinion and published studies
- Enhance on-going community development efforts such as Communities For A Lifetime, Otsego County Master Plan, Michigan Main Street Program, and Mobilizing for Action through Planning & Partnerships (MAPP)
