More than 100 runners took part in the first annual Alpine Village Festival Run. Top Gaylord finisher was David Thomas, third, who covered the eight-mile course in 42:05.

Deni Kujat, daughter of Dan and Betty Kujat, was crowned queen of Alpenfest, and Lisa Koenigsknecht was the first runner-up.

The Gaylord Area Chamber of Commerce (now the Gaylord / Otsego County Chamber of Commerce) won the prize for best overall float in the Alpenfest Grand Parade, with Gaylord Rotary the runner-up.

Robert Libke served as parade marshal for the grand parade.
