Vernacular Italianate (1840-1885):

Although the current condition of the home offers no clues to the homes' original character, historic photos show the home once had distinct vernacular Italianate features. The home's distinctive bay windows at the front and side were once elaborately detailed and centered beneath a pair of classic Italianate windows with extravagant labels. The bays are now indistinct and have been sided over and extended to the roofline. All elaborate windows have been replaced with vinyl.
